EXPERIENCE IN LITHUANIA

The visit to the University of Siauliai took place during the second week of September, in partnership with the Department of Social Welfare Studies and Physical Education, specifically in the Social Work course. In addition to the sessions on "Child Abuse and Child Protection" and "Foster Care and children rights", a workshop was held entitled "Foster Care in Pictures Books for Children", which had the active collaboration of second- and third-year students. I also had meetings of sharing and comparing the curricula of both institutions and child protection systems, studying possibilities of developing projects in the future. The Lithuanian colleagues who organized the visit were very available and welcoming, highlighting Prof. Liuda Radzeviciene (Head of Department) and Prof. Lina Miliuniene (Vice-Dean). In addition to daily follow-up at the University, they organized a visit to the Hill of Crosses on the outskirts of Siauliai and Klaipedia, the third city and the only port in the country, providing a historical and cultural learning experience that complemented the learner and institutional dimension.

The city of Siauliai was totally destroyed in World War II, and the marks of the Soviet occupation are still visible, in its moth and in several buildings, namely the University itself. This modern and nice city is in a phase of renovation of streets and squares, of development and reinforcement of the local identity and of the territory.

Lithuania is an aging country, with an effective population decrease and a corresponding reduction in the number of students, which poses obvious challenges for the future of Higher Education Institutions. Therefore, the integration of the University of Siauliai at the University of Vilnius is being study at the present. In the context of child protection, Lithuania is developing a process of deinstitutionalization, in order to reduce the burden of institutions in the reception of children in danger, similar to Portugal is trying to do.

The objectives of this short experience of mobility were thus achieved allowing for personal and professional experience, the exchange of social and cultural experiences and the deepening of institutional cooperation.



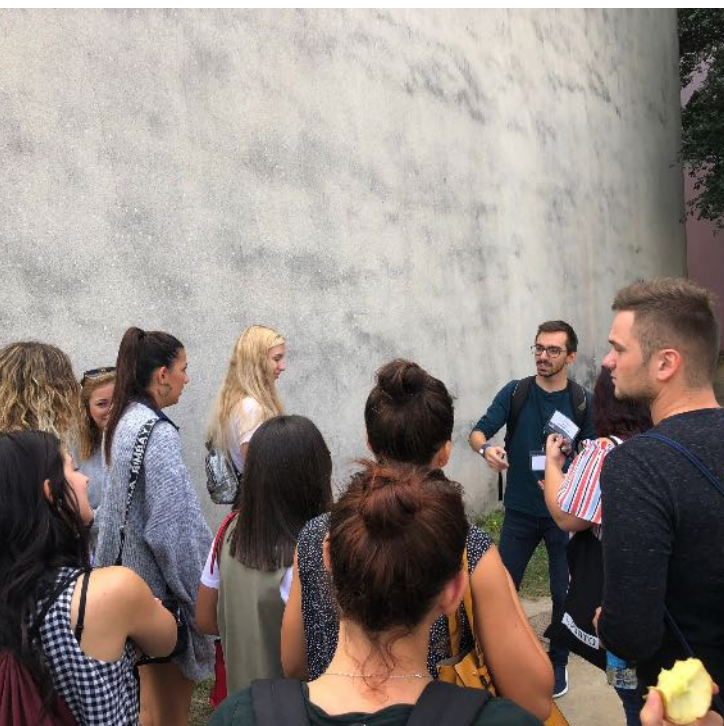

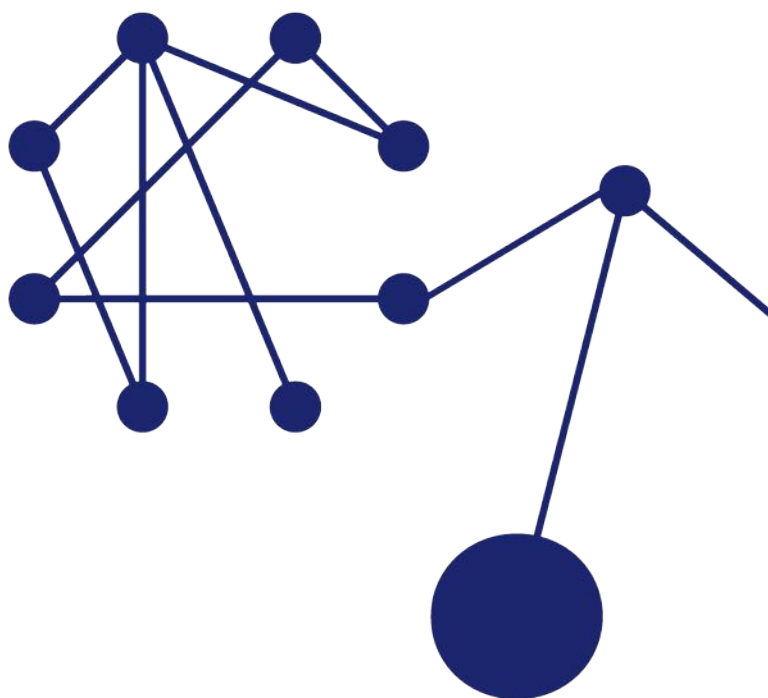
INTERNETWORKING 2019 CONFERENCE / INTERNATIONAL WEEK
